

Qualifications for Public Asset Engineering and Management

InfraTrain has developed new qualifications that cover the design, building and management of public infrastructure assets. These national qualifications have been developed with the infrastructure industry and are endorsed by the major industry associations.

The qualifications provide either recognition of knowledge and skills of a council's own staff; or a best-practice standard to specify in engineering standards or tender documents.

The presentation will provide an overview of the qualifications:-

National Diploma in Infrastructure Asset Management

A new world-class qualification, developed in association with the NAMS Group, for management of a wide range of public assets.

National Certificate in Infrastructure Pipelaying

Developed specifically to cover the unique requirements of infrastructure pipelaying. The appropriate qualification to now specify for work on Crown or Council land.

National Diploma in Civil Engineering (Applied)

A replacement for the former NZCE (Civil) – recognises practical skills.

National Certificates in Civil Construction

A suite of new, updated qualifications for civil construction.
