Purpose

To encourage INGENIUM members to present papers on asset management and engineering for infrastructure.

Objectives

- To secure a selection of papers for presentation to annual conferences of INGENIUM. In 2009 the conference will be at Hamilton, 4 - 6 June.
- To develop a library of "papers" for the benefit of our industry.
- To publish papers prepared by INGENIUM members.
- To encourage members to develop their presentation skills.

- To foster exchange of information and improve standards of asset management and engineering for infrastructure.

Value

The winning presenter will receive return airfares for two (ie winner and partner) from Auckland, Wellington or Christchurch to present the winning paper at the biennial conference of the **Institute of Public Works Engineering Australia**, to be held in **Melbourne** over the period **6 to 10 September 2009**. This conference is an International Public Works Conference, and will be held jointly with the **IFME World Congress on Municipal Engineering**. [IFME is the International Federation of Municipal Engineering, of which INGENIUM is a member.] The prize includes accommodation for the period of the conference, airport transfers, and delegate and partner conference registration fees.

Prizes of mystery weekends for two will be presented to the two runners up.

All entrants who provide a complying paper that is not accepted for presentation in the Hynds Paper competition will receive a gift vouchers to the value of \$100.

This competition is open to all INGENIUM members.
